On 8th march every year this day celebrated as an International Women's Day in all over the world. Even in India, various events are celebrated on the occasion of this Women's Day. Women who are leading in various fields are also given awards and some reasons and history of celebrating the women's day.

1. Women in most of the world, including the Americas and Europe, were denied the right to vote until the early 20th century.

2. Consistent example of male and female in a patriarchal system were struggling against this injustice.

3. At the First International Socialist Women's Conference in Stuttgart in 1904, Balara Zetzen, a very militant Communist activist, declared that it was the duty of socialist women to fight for universal human rights, and on March 8, 1908, thousands of women garment workers in New York Gathered in the square and made huge historical demonstrations. Demands were made for a 10-star rate and safety at work. Along with these wreaths, Clara Zetkin joined this broad movement of American black women demanding equal rights for all adult men and women regardless of gender, race, property, and educational background. In 1910, at the Second International Socialist Women's Conference held in Copenhagen, March 8 became a world trend to commemorate the historic achievement of American women on March 8, 1908. After this resolution, campaigns for universal suffrage were launched in Europe, America, etc. As a result, these demands were successful in England in 1918 and in America in 1918. After that, March 8 was celebrated all over the world. To celebrate the International Women's Day Team organized a program in our college. This program was attended by the students of the college with full participation and female employees. The significance of the day, 8 March, was disputed.
