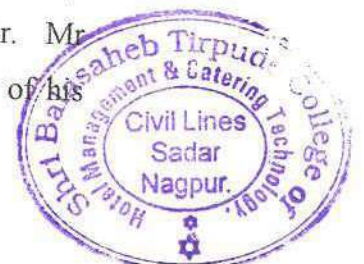
EVENT DETAILS

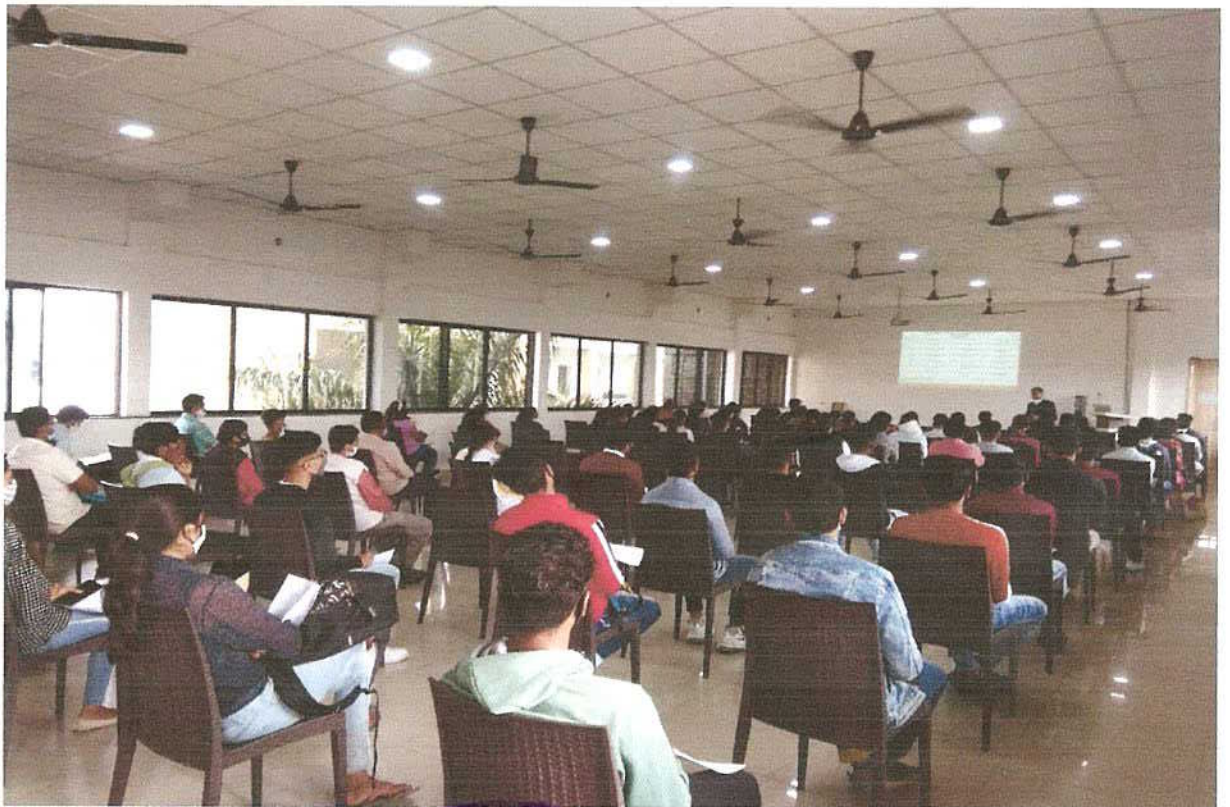

General Rules and Regulations

All the students are hereby informed to follow the rules and regulations which are imposed in an effort to seed professionalism in individual and understand the need of self-discipline.

1. Every student must obtain on admission, the Identity Card which must have his/her photograph attested and wear the identity card on person whenever he/she is on the college premises, and present it for inspection on demand.
2. Students joining the College are bound by the rules and regulations of the College.
3. All applications must be addressed to the principal.
4. Every student is required to maintain a minimum of 75% attendance separately for lectures, tutorials and/or practical conducted for each semester / term, failing which the terms will not be granted, and the student cannot appear for the term end and/or annual examination conducted by the College on behalf of the University. The over all aggregate percentage is 75%.
5. Students must not loiter in the College premises while the classes are going on.
6. In case of absence on account of illness, the Principal should be informed by the parents personally. On resuming the college the student should report to the Principal along with the fitness certificate.
7. Continued absence without leave for more than 03 working days will render a student liable to get his / her parents to the college on the 4th day and meet the respective class teacher and the principal.
8. It is mandatory for the parents to attend Parents- Teacher Meet and take the updates of the students.
9. Students must not attend classes other than their own, without the permission of the Principal. No student shall leave the classroom during a lecture without the permission of the teacher. Attendance will be taken at the beginning of each hour. A student who is not in the class when attendance is taken will be marked absent.
10. Smoking and consumption of alcohol on the College premises or entering the college premises, after consuming alcoholic drinks is strictly prohibited.
11. Late-comers will not be admitted to the class without any admission slip from the principal or a person authorized by him for the purpose.
12. Students shall do nothing either inside or outside the College that will in any way interfere with its orderly conduct and discipline.
13. Students attending classes, meetings or other gathering within the college are expected to be presentably dressed in accordance with approved etiquette. Students should not wear collarless t-shirts/ polo neck/ turtleneck t-shirts.



- walls, doors, fittings or breaking furniture, misuse of fittings, or breaking furniture, misuse of A.C. etc., is breach of discipline, and the guilty will be duly punished.
29. Students should not leave their books, valuables and other belongings in the classroom.
 30. If, in the opinion of the Principal, for any reason, the continuance of a student in the College is detrimental to the best interest of the College, the Principal may ask such a student to leave the College without assigning reason for his/her decision.
 31. Insubordination and unbecoming language or misconduct on the part of a student are sufficient reasons for his/her suspension or dismissal. Students are expected to behave properly with female colleagues and staff.
 32. Students who are guilty of (a) rude language towards the staff of the college. (b) assaulting or attempting to assault fellow-students or the college employees or other staff of the college will attract disciplinary action against them.
 33. Students receiving Government or College Scholarships or any remission in fees, must note that the grant and continuance thereof are subject to good behaviour, regular attendance and satisfactory progress and good results at the College.
 34. All College activities are organized under the guidance and supervision of the Principal and Professor In-Charge.
 35. Students must not associate themselves with any activity not authorized by the College Principal.
 36. Students using unfair means at examinations will not be readmitted to the College. Actions will be initiated against such students as per the norms and procedure prescribed by the University.
 37. It is the responsibility of the students to read the notice boards regularly for important announcements made by the College office from time to time. They will not be excused or given any concession on grounds of ignorance or not reading notices.
 38. During the lectures use of any electronic devices containing any audio or video will be prohibited in the class room.
 39. Maintenance of Discipline within the college campus is of almost importance. Any students involved in RAGGING of any sort directly or indirectly shall be dismissed from the college immediately in addition to facing action by the Law enforcing authority. And undertaking to this effect is to be signed by students and Parents. Students expelled on grounds of indiscipline will not be entitled to any refund of any fees or the deposit.
 40. Matters not covered by the existing rules will rest at the absolute discretion of the Principal.





General Rules and Regulations

All the students are hereby informed to follow the rules and regulations which are imposed in an effort to seed professionalism in individual and understand the need of self-discipline.

1. Every student must obtain on admission, the Identity Card which must have his/her photograph attested and wear the identity card on person whenever he/she is on the college premises, and present it for inspection on demand.
2. Students joining the College are bound by the rules and regulations of the College.
3. All applications must be addressed to the principal.
4. Every student is required to maintain a minimum of 70% attendance separately for lectures, tutorials and/or practical conducted for each semester / term. failing which the terms will not be granted, and the student cannot appear for the term end and/or annual examination conducted by the College on behalf of the University. The over all aggregate percentage is 75%.
5. Students must not loiter in the College premises while the classes are going on.
6. In case of absence on account of illness, the Principal should be informed by the parents personally. On resuming the college, the student should report to the Principal along with the fitness certificate.
7. Continued absence without leave for more than 03 working days will render a student liable to get his / her parents to the college on the 4th day and meet the respective class teacher and the principal.
8. It is mandatory for the parents to attend Parents- Teacher Meet and take the updates of the students.
9. Students must not attend classes other than their own, without the permission of the Principal. No student shall leave the classroom during a lecture without the permission of the teacher. Attendance will be taken at the beginning of each hour. A student who is not in the class when attendance is taken will be marked absent.
10. Smoking and consumption of alcohol on the College premises or entering the college premises, after consuming alcoholic drinks is strictly prohibited.
11. Late-comers will not be admitted to the class without any admission slip from the principal or a person authorized by him for the purpose.
12. Students shall do nothing either inside or outside the College that will in any way interfere with its orderly conduct and discipline.
13. Students attending classes, meetings or other gathering within the college are expected to be presentably dressed in accordance with approved etiquette. Students should not wear collarless t-shirts/ polo neck/ turtleneck t-shirts.
14. The boys are expected to be in formal pants, with the shirt neatly tucked in and in polished leather shoes. Any other dress and footwear is not permitted.
15. Girl students should wear saree in proper form while attending Front Office subject practicals and in good make-up in all other practicals.
16. Students should not operate any machinery / equipment without the permission of the instructor
17. When a student meets a member of staff for the first time in the day, he / she must greet him / her appropriately.



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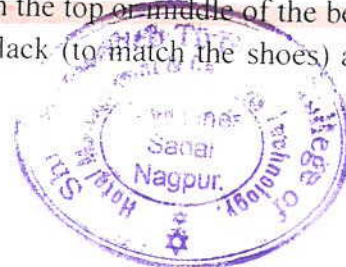
35. Students must not associate themselves with any activity not authorized by the College Principal.
36. Students using unfair means at examinations will not be readmitted to the College. Actions will be initiated against such students as per the norms and procedure prescribed by the University.
37. It is the responsibility of the students to read the notice boards regularly for important announcements made by the College office from time to time. They will not be excused or given any concession on grounds of ignorance or not reading notices.
38. During the lectures use of any electronic devices containing any audio or video will be prohibited in the class room.
39. Maintenance of Discipline within the college campus is of almost importance. Any students involved in RAGGING of any sort directly or indirectly shall be dismissed from the college immediately in addition to facing action by the Law enforcing authority. And undertaking to this effect is to be signed by students and Parents. Students expelled on grounds of indiscipline will not be entitled to any refund of any fees or the deposit.
40. Matters not covered by the existing rules will rest at the absolute discretion of the Principal.

Grooming standards for all students

To maintain the quality image of college, it is important that all students project a fresh, professional, conservative, and well-groomed appearance at all times maintaining the highest standards of personal hygiene.

On college academic days, students shall only be seen in uniform AT ALL TIMES while in the college campus. This includes before college hours, during college hours and even college hours after. Being caught in campus wearing any other clothing apart from sanctioned uniform will be actioned. If a student has to come to college on a non-working day (for example to make a submission or to meet the principal) or during industrial training for any reason whatsoever, he/she must be semi-formally attired (no jeans, collar or T-shirt, short, chappals/floater) with tucked-in shirt, acceptable footwear and proper grooming, shall not be attended to and shall be asked to exit the premises.

- Only uniforms and accessories prescribed and outfitted by the college have to be worn by students.
- Replacement of any element of any uniform need to be identical to the original.
- Kitchen shoes are to be used only in food production areas.
- Uniforms should not be altered in any way and worn properly and it must be clean, spotless, well maintained and ironed.
- Shirts/tops must be buttoned up at all times.
- Suitably coloured non-revealing inner garments must be worn. On neck white coloured t-shirt is purposed inside the chef coat.
- Trousers must be of the correct length.
- Footwear must be cleaned/polished daily.
- Plain black socks without design or embroidery to be worn. Ties design should be conservative. The tip end of the tie to touch the top or middle of the belt buckle.
- Belts (not outfitted by college) must be black (to match the shoes) and must sport a plain conservative style.



- Clean shave daily (using a sharp razor): beards, goatees, soul patch, Fu-Man-Chu, handlebar moustaches are not permitted.
- Moustaches must be neat, freshly trimmed, and should not exceed past the corner of the mouth and should not cover the upper lip.
- Fancy, wild and fashionable hairstyles are disallowed.
- Clean, professional looking, freshly styled hair, worn short and well combed with the back hairline above the collar.
- All Sikh (male) students should wear black turbans only.
- Hair should not cover ears.
- Sideburns, not longer than the mid-ear section.
- Moderate use of gels, mousses and hairsprays.

Students who are inappropriately dressed or groomed will be sent home and directed to return to work in proper attire. Such students will not be compensated for the time away from college work. Students will also be subject to disciplinary action including termination for violating the grooming standard policy.

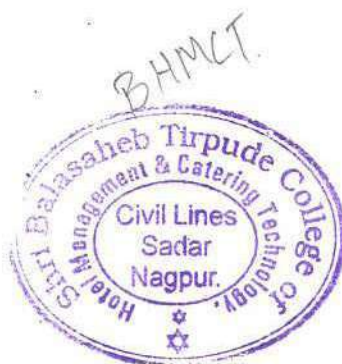

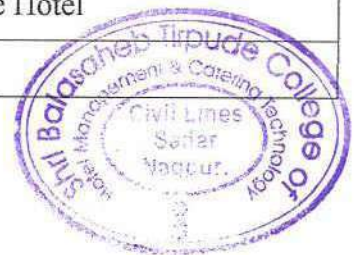

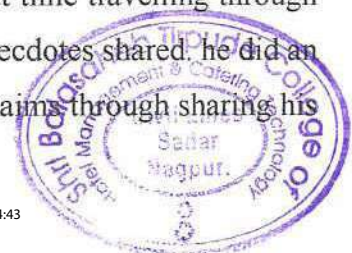
