



Information about the Dr. S. R. Ranganathan

He was born on 12the august 1892, he lived in shiyali in south India.

Ranganathan began his professional He earned B.A and M.A degrees in Mathematics from Madras Christian college in his home province and then went on to earn a teaching license.

His most notable contributions to the field were his five laws of library science- synthetic classification system, the colon classification.

He is considered to be the father of library science, documentation and information science in India. His five laws of library science are helpful in formulating principles of document selection.

In 1928, Dr. S.R Ranganathan formulated the fundamental laws of library science on the basis of his own experience, observation and experiment on the working of the library. In 1931 he published his books "Five Laws of Library Science".

The 1st law- Books are for use.

2<sup>nd</sup> law- Every reader his or her book.

- 3<sup>rd</sup> law- Every book its reader.
- 4th law- Save the time of the reader.

5<sup>th</sup> law- The library is a growing organism.

- 2) Every listener her/ his iTunes
- 3) Every blog its reader.
- 4) Save the time for the listener.
- 5) A E-library is a growing organism.


New conception laws is very useful in information technology age. The National Librarian Day concluded with enthusiasm.






