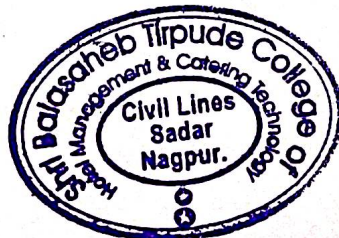

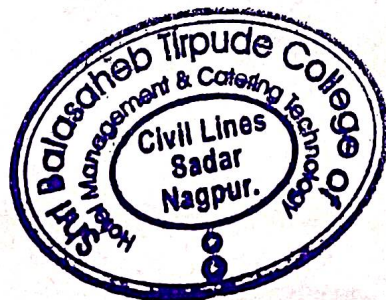

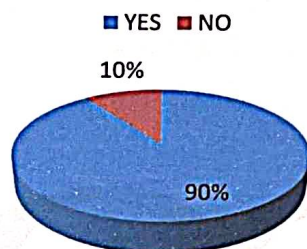

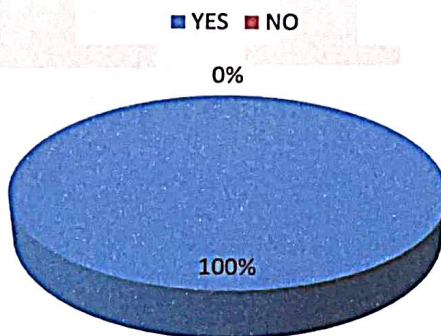

Q1. Is there any relevancy between the Content of course and the units?

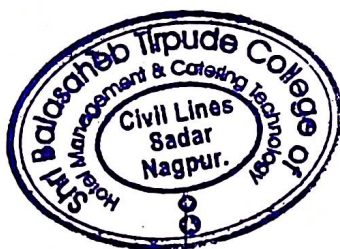


90% students positively agree relevance in course content and units.

100% students strongly accepted curriculum is career oriented.



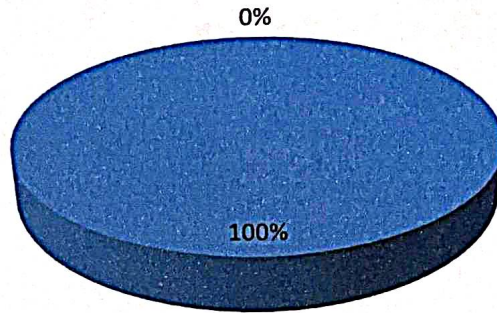

Q3 Does the curriculum prepares you for the real-life situations?

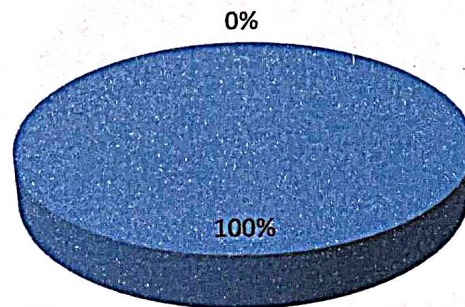

100% students strongly agree they are ready for the real-life situations through curriculum.

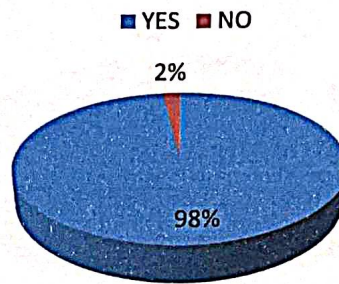
Q4. Whether the size of the curriculum in terms of the load on the student is distributed properly?

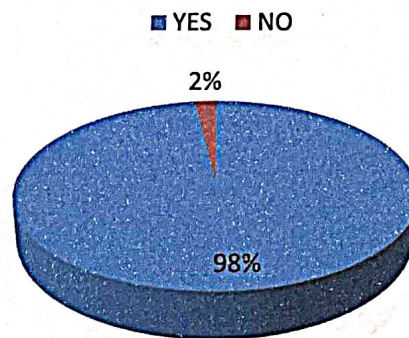
100% students supported the load is distributed properly.

Q5. Do you feel that the curriculum is useful in terms of knowledge (theoretical as well as practical) and concepts?



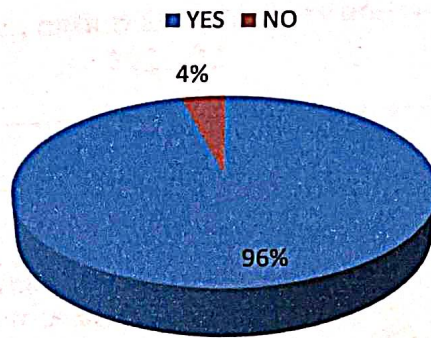
98% students correlate knowledge (theoretical as well as practical) and concepts.

Q6. Whether the depth of curriculum content is sufficient enough to gain knowledge (theoretical as well as practical)?



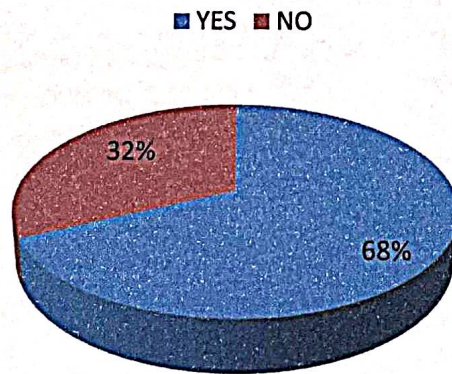
98% students agreed the depth of content is enough to gain knowledge (theoretical as well as practical).

Q7. Does the college has sufficient library holdings for the curriculum of the course?

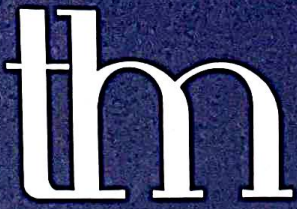


96% students strongly accepted library facility enough to cover curriculum.
